We are proud to share that Battle River Power Coop was awarded Best Commercial Entry at the 2025 Kick'n Country Parade in Camrose, Alberta.

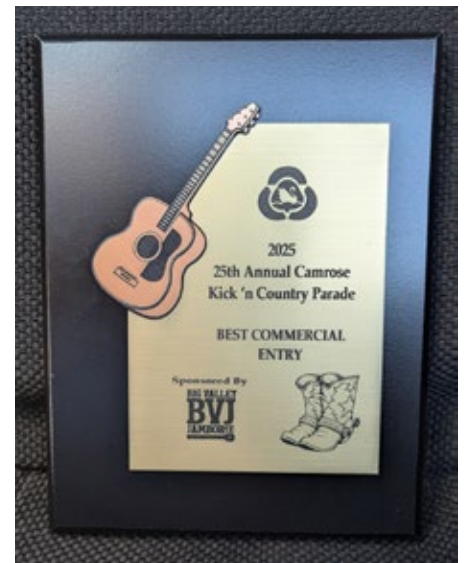

Let's work together to keep this harvest season safe for everyone.

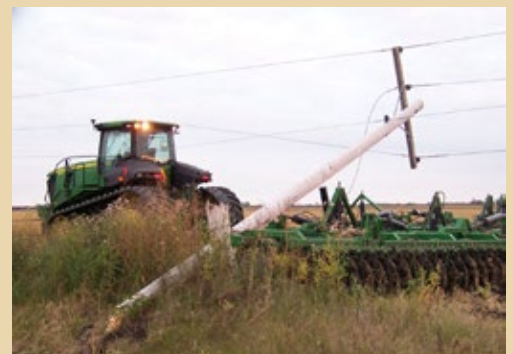
